Code amendment proposals for the 2010 Oregon Manufactured Dwelling Installation Specialty Code

On September 1, 2009, the division will begin accepting code amendment proposals for the 2010 Oregon Manufactured Dwelling Installation Specialty Code.

Affected Codes:

The current manufactured dwelling installation code in Oregon is the 2002 Oregon Manufactured Dwelling and Parks Specialty Code (MD&P). The division proposes to adopt an amended version of the 2002 MD&P with the [2010 Oregon Manufactured Dwelling Installation Specialty Code](#) (MDISC), which was developed by the Building Codes Division.

The MDISC was developed to achieve the following goals:

- Stay within the statutory framework for manufactured dwelling installations
- Align the code with federal installation requirements
- Provide a uniform and consistent Chapter 1
- Separate manufactured dwelling park construction from the installation code

Timetable:

The division will accept proposed code amendments any time from September 1, 2009 through October 15, 2009. No proposals will be accepted after October 15, 2009. Any interested person may propose amendments to the code.

Proposal Process:

All proposals must be submitted to the division in writing. The division is providing the Code Amendment Proposal Application that includes the code amendment proposal criteria to make the submittal process easier. Any interested person may propose to:

- Add an amendment to the proposed MDISC; or
- Make recommendations to incorporate statewide code interpretations, or alternate method rulings into the newly adopted code.

All accepted proposals will be reviewed by a code review committee. The committee is expected to have public meetings beginning in mid September 2009. The Manufactured Structures and Parks Advisory Board will meet in November 2009 to review the proposed code changes and make a recommendation to the division. There will be an additional opportunity for input at a public hearing in December of 2009. The 2010 Oregon Manufactured Dwelling Installation Specialty Code is scheduled to be effective April 1, 2010.
