10 Pursuant to ORS 455.895(1)(b) and OAR 918-001-0036, the Electrical and Elevator Board proposes
11 to impose a civil penalty against you in the amount of \$13,000

12 **FINDINGS OF FACT**

- 13 1. On or about November 2005 to January 4, 2006 at 777 9th St, NW, Suite 104, Corvallis,
14 Oregon, Respondent engaged in the business of installing electrical wiring for a fire alarm system,
15 for the account of another, without a valid Oregon electrical contractor's license.
- 16 2. On or about November 2005 to January 4, 2006 at 777 9th St, NW, Suite 104, Corvallis,
17 Oregon, Respondent engaged in the business of installing electrical wiring for a fire alarm system,
18 for the account of another, without first obtaining a valid electrical permit.
- 19 3. On January 25, 2006, a Notice of Proposed Assessment of Civil Penalty and Order of
20 Corrective Action was issued to Respondent. The Order of Corrective Action directed Respondent
21 to obtain a valid electrical permit and submit a copy to the Division no later than 5:00 P.M.,
22 February 13, 2006. Respondent has failed to comply with the Order of Corrective Action.

23 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

- 24 1. The installation of electrical wiring for a fire alarm system as outlined in the Findings of Fact, is
25 an electrical installation under ORS 479.530(10).
- 26 2. By engaging in the business of making an electrical installation without a valid Oregon
27 electrical contractors license, as set forth in Finding of Fact (1), Respondent violated ORS
28 479.620(1).
- 29 3. By making an electrical installation without first obtaining a valid electrical permit, as set forth
30 in Finding of Fact (2), Respondent violated ORS 479.550(1).

2 4. By failing to comply with the Order of Corrective Action previously issued, Respondent violated ORS 455.450(1).

3 **ORDER**

4 1. Pursuant to ORS 455.895(1)(b) and OAR 918-001-0036, the Electrical and Elevator Board finds Respondent violated ORS 479.620(1) and is assessed a \$5,000 civil penalty; and

5 2. Pursuant to ORS 455.895(1)(b) and OAR 918-001-0036, the Electrical and Elevator Board finds Respondent violated ORS 479.550(1) is assessed a \$3000 civil penalty.

7 Pursuant to ORS 455.895(2) and OAR 918-001-0036, the Director of the Department of Consumer and Business Services finds Respondent violated ORS 455.450(1) and is assessed a \$5,000 civil penalty;

9 For a total civil penalty of \$13,000.00.

10 The \$13,000 civil penalty is due and payable on or before 5:00 P.M. March 27, 2006. Failure to submit payment by the due date indicated above will result in your account being forwarded to the Department's Business Administration Division for collection. The Department will pursue collection of unpaid civil penalties by filing a lien against your real estate holdings, by tax refund offsets through the Department of Revenue, or through an outside collection agent.
