Oregonians warned not to deal with unlicensed entities State Adjustment or Major Finance

(SALEM) The Division of Finance & Corporate Securities has received complaints concerning the unregistered/unauthorized collection activities of State Adjustment Inc. The company known as State Adjustment Inc. is not licensed and may no longer legally engage in the work of a collection agency. C. Philip Zurfluh had been registered with the Office of the Secretary of State as the registered agent and Brenda Holm as secretary for State Adjustment Inc. They may be continuing to offer services under those auspices. Zurfluh has another business listed with the secretary of state, Major Finance Co. Major Finance is not licensed with the State of Oregon as a collection agency.

Anyone who has been contacted by State Adjustment or Major Finance Co. with respect to collection activities since June 2003 should contact the Division of Finance and Corporate Securities. If State Adjustment or Major Finance attempted to collect money from you by calling, filing suit against you in court, or filing garnishments to force you to pay debt (since June 2003), please contact the Division of Finance and Corporate Securities, (503) 378-4140, and ask to speak to Rob Bruner.
