CONSENT TO ENTRY OF ORDER**

The Director of the Department of Consumer and Business Services for the State of Oregon (hereinafter "the Director") acting by the authority of the Chapter 59 of the Oregon Revised Statutes (hereinafter cited as "the Oregon Mortgage Lender Law"), hereby issues the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, Order and Notice of Right to a Public Hearing:

FINDINGS OF FACT

The Director FINDS that:

1. Patricia Tellez, born December 21, 1973, assisted a loan originator for a mortgage broker or banker licensed by the Director by completing a verification of employment.
2. On or about June 15, 2004, a Yamhill County Grand Jury indicted Patricia Tellez on one count of Fraud and Deceit with Respect to Mortgage Banker or Broker Business under ORS 59.930, a class C felony.
3. On June 28, 2005, Patricia Tellez entered a plea of guilty to one count of Fraud and Deceit with Respect to Mortgage Banker or Broker Business under ORS 59.930, a

1 class C felony.

2 4. The crime of Fraud and Deceive with Respect to Mortgage Banker or Broker
3 Business is a crime involving a false statement or dishonesty as those terms are used in
4 OAR 441-880-0050(4)(b).

5 5. As part of the plea agreement, Patricia Tellez agreed to sign a "written
6 agreement with the State that she will never work as a Loan Officer, Loan Originator,
7 Mortgage Broker, Mortgage Banker or Financial Advisor."

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CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

10 The Director **CONCLUDES** that:

11 1. By pleading guilty to one count of Fraud and Deceit with Respect to Mortgage
12 Banker or Broker Business under ORS 59.930, Patricia Tellez admitted that she
13 violated ORS 59.930.

14 2. OAR 441-880-0050(4)(a) provides that a felony, described as "crimes
15 punishable by death or imprisonment in excess of one year under the law under which
16 the person was convicted," is among the categories of criminal convictions that will
17 prevent a person from acting as a loan originator.

18 3. Because, on June 28, 2005, Patricia Tellez entered a plea of guilty to and a
19 conviction was entered for one count of Fraud and Deceit with Respect to Mortgage
20 Banker or Broker Business under ORS 59.930, a class C felony, ORS 59.971(2)
21 prohibits Patricia Tellez from acting as a loan originator as defined in ORS 59.840 or
22 59.970.


23 4. OAR 441-880-0050(4)(b) provides that any crime involving false statement or
24 dishonesty is among the categories of criminal convictions that will prevent a person
25 from acting as a loan originator.

26 5. Because, on June 28, 2005, Patricia Tellez entered a plea of guilty to and a

22 defined in ORS 59.840(4) and ORS 59.970; own or operate as a mortgage banker or
23 mortgage broker, as those terms are defined in ORS 59.840(5) and (7) respectively; act
24 as a partner, officer, director, or experienced person as described in ORS 59.850(2), or
25 occupy similar status or perform similar functions of a partner, officer director or
26 experienced person for a mortgage banker or mortgage broker; own, act as, or act in a

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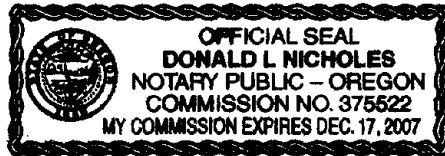
1 managerial capacity in a company required to have a consumer finance license under
2 ORS 725.045; or act as an agent or facilitator, as those terms are used in ORS
3 725.610, for the purpose of making a payday or title loan, as those terms are defined in
4 725.600(3) and (4) respectively.
