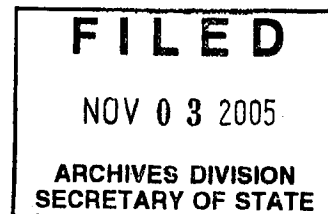



RULE SUMMARY

Amends OAR 438-006-0095 by adding a provision that, when an Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) disqualifies himself or herself, the ALJ is not required to disclose the reason or reasons for the disqualification except as required by law.
