Compensable fatalities are claims accepted by insurers arising from a fatal occupational injury or disease that entitle workers or their survivors to compensation. Data exclude deaths of exempt workers, such as workers who were self-employed, worked in Oregon for out-of-state employers, city of Portland police and fire employees, or federal employees. Claims characteristics are listed according to the Occupational Injury and Illness Classification System (OICS Version 2.01).

Data are based on the date the Department of Consumer and Business Services received notification the fatal claim was accepted, which may differ from the date of injury or illness, or date of death.

Industries are grouped and classified according to the North American Industry Classification System (NAICS), 2007 edition. Employees of client leasing firms are reported in the industry in which they were working at the time of injury.

Inv = Investigation. A plus sign (+) indicates Oregon OSHA investigated the fatality. Oregon OSHA investigates certain fatalities within its jurisdiction to determine if the incident might have been prevented by complying with safety and health standards. Tenure is the number of months an employee had worked for the employer at the time of the fatal injury or diagnosis of fatal illness. N/A = tenure was not reported. A value of <1 indicates less than one month on the job.
