The Director of the Oregon Department of Consumer and Business Services (director) commenced this administrative proceeding, pursuant to Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 731.256, to take enforcement action against Koua Moua (Moua).

The director makes the following final decision in this proceeding.

Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law

Licensing Information

Moua has been licensed in Oregon as a nonresident individual insurance producer from since 9/12/08. Moua's last recorded residence and business address is located in Merced, California.

In Arrears in Child Support Obligation

Moua is subject to disciplinary action pursuant to ORS 25.780(1) because of the following circumstances. ORS 25.780(1) requires an "entity that issues licenses, certificates, permits or registrations that a person is required by state law to possess to engaged in an occupation, [or] profession ...to suspend without further hearing the license, certificate, permit or registration of a person upon certification by the administrator [as defined in ORS 25.010(1)] that the person is subject to an order suspending the license, certificate, permit or registration. The certification must include the information specified in ORS 25.750(1)." ORS 25.783 prohibits an entity from releasing or making other use of information received by the entity pursuant to ORS 25.750 to 25.783 except that if the entity receives an inquiry into the status of a person who has had a license, certificate, permit or registration suspended under ORS 25.750 to 25.783 then the entity shall respond only that the license, certificate, permit or registration was suspended pursuant to ORS 25.750 to

25.783. On 3/30/10, the director received from the Oregon Department of Justice a Notice to Suspend dated 3/25/10 certifying that Moua is subject to an order suspending Moua's Oregon insurance producer license. The certification included the information specified in ORS 25.750(1).

Order

Pursuant to ORS 744.074(1) and ORS 25.780(1), Moua's Oregon nonresident individual insurance producer license is suspended and shall not be renewed; and any other license authorized by ORS Chapter 744 shall not be issued to Moua, from the date of this order until (1) the director receives from the Oregon Department of Justice a written notice pursuant to ORS 25.774 that the director may reinstate or renew the suspended license or issue a new license, and (2) Moua otherwise qualifies for a license.

Notice of Right to Judicial Review

A party has the right to judicial review of this order pursuant to ORS 183.480 and ORS 183.482. A party may request judicial review by sending a petition for judicial review to the Oregon Court of Appeals. The court must receive the petition within 60 days from the date this order was served on the party. If the order was personally delivered to a party, then the date of service is the date the party received the order. If the order was mailed to a party, then the date of service is the date the order was mailed to the party, not the date the party received the order.
